

WOUND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

For a biopsy with NO stiches:

- 1) Keep the area clean and dressing dry and in place for 24 hours.
- 2) After 24 hours you may shower normally.
- 3) Gently clean the area with soap or cleanser (Dove or Olay) and water once or twice a day. Pat dry and apply a pea sized amount of Aquaphor or Vaseline and cover with a bandaid.
- 4) Avoid Neosporin and Bacitracin.
- 5) Keep moist and covered until completely healed.
- 6) Please call our office if you do not receive notification of biopsy results within one week.

For a biopsy or excision WITH stiches:

- 1) Keep the area clean and the dressing dry and in place for 24 hours.
- 2) After 24 hours you may shower. Avoid submerging the area under water in swimming pool, whirlpool, lake, or ocean.
- 3) Gently clean the area with soap or cleanser (Dove or Olay) and water once or twice a day. Pay dry and apply a pea sized amount of Aquaphor or Vaseline then over with a bandaid.
- 4) Avoid Neosporin and Bacitracin.
- 5) Do not leave the area "open to air" as this well impede wound healing.
- 6) Take Acetaminophen (Tylenol) for any discomfort as per the package instructions.
- 7) Return for suture removal as instructed by your doctor.
- 8) Please call our office if you do not receive notification of biopsy or excision results within one week.

You should be contacted by our office with biopsy results within 1 week of your biopsy. If you have not received results in 1 week, please call our office for the results.

Fever/Chills
Increasing Tenderness
Increasing Redness
Increasing Warmth
Thick or foul smelling drainage
Increased discomfort or pain



If bleeding occurs apply continuous pressure for 10 minutes. Call our office if bleeding persists.
